Because striving for perfection leads to paralysis, Master Pastelist Jen Evenhus kicks perfection out the window, giving students permission to explore, experiment and play with pastel and other materials such as markers, brushes and graphite to create bold, expressive works of art as we step fearlessly toward the unknown. Using timed exercises to loosen up and reveal your innate intuition forces us to use bold strokes with wild abandon, creating happy little accidents and mark-making that reveal your personal style.

Students will work with landscape photos provided by instructor, with their own photo reference, with still life / floral objects, and weather permitting, do some plein air sketching.

We will use contemporary impressionist, expressionist and abstract styles as we explore shapes, composition, positive and negative space, bold vs neutral color and mark-making.

There will be plenty of challenging exercises, instructor demos, one-on-one coaching, critiques, discussions, and painting throughout this intense fun workshop with PSA Master Pastelist Jen Evenhus. Come with an open mind and a willing spirit!
